

OPERATION OF TENNIS COURT LIGHTS

The control box for the operation of the tennis court lights is located on the front wall at the right side of the clubhouse building inside the wrought iron fence. The control box can be accessed through the fence.

Lights work from 5pm to 10pm, daily. Report problems to BCR HOA MANAGEMENT at 979-703-1819.

How to use the buttons:

GREEN BUTTON:

Press the Green Button to start the lights. They will come on after a brief warm up and stay on for 90 minutes.

RED BUTTON:

Press the Red Button to turn off the lights after you complete play and there is no one else on the courts.

ALARM:

The Alarm sounds after the first 80 minutes that the lights are on. To continue lights for another 90 minutes you must again press the Green Button within 10 minutes of the Alarm sounding. If lights go off, there is a delay on the restart that protects the lights.

DEPARTURE:

If you turned the lights on, you are ready to leave, and there are others on the courts; please ask the remaining players to turn off the lights if they are the last to leave.

PRIVATE TENNIS CLUB RULES

1. The tennis courts are only for homeowners and their guests. At all times, at least one player using a court must be a homeowner. No homeowner has the authority to grant approval to anyone to use the tennis facility unless that homeowner is present and actively engaged on the court participating in the activity.
2. The EFHOA prohibits the use of any of its facilities by anyone to engage in any money making enterprise. This prohibition includes the use of the tennis courts to conduct tennis lessons.
3. The tennis courts are available from sun up until 10p.m. daily.
4. There are no reservations. If others are waiting to play, limit play as follows: Singles: 1.5 hours, Doubles: 2 hours.
5. The courts are for tennis ONLY! Any other activities, such as rollerblading, soccer, or bicycling, etc. are NOT ALLOWED. Persons damaging the courts will be held responsible. Tennis courts are monitored with security cameras.
6. Players will keep tennis courts clean. All trash should be picked up and placed in the garbage can before leaving. We do not provide a cleaning service for the courts.
7. Parents are responsible for informing and enforcing the tennis court rules for their children.
8. Loitering after 10p.m. is not allowed and should be reported to the College Station Police Dept. at 979-764-3600 or International Security, Inc. at 979-690-1812.
9. Court abuse or other rule violations should be reported to BCR HOA Management at 979-703-1819.
